We had two fantastic performances of musical talent from West End Comes To Wellington last week. The Glee Club were amazing! Well done all.



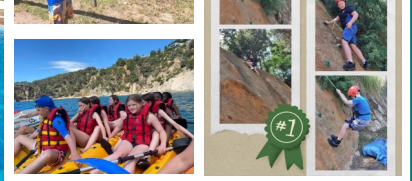
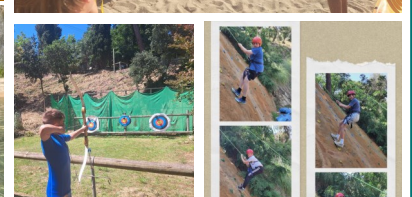
Court Fields Interhouse Euro 2024

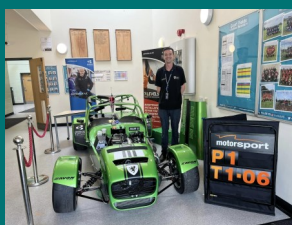
Spain Trip
