Non-Uniform Day

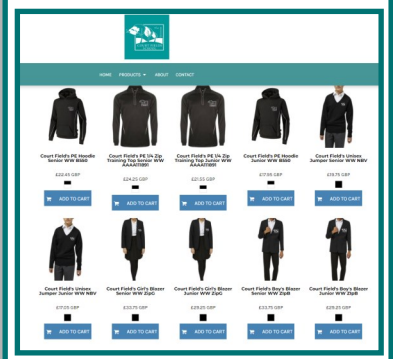

These quizzes support students to develop their recall of core knowledge in Science leading to improved confidence and attainment in lessons. It can also support students that have been absent to learn the core knowledge they might have missed. Each quiz self marks and gives students the correct answer, often with an explanation, if the student is incorrect. Students should resit the quiz multiple times, aiming to achieve over 80%.
